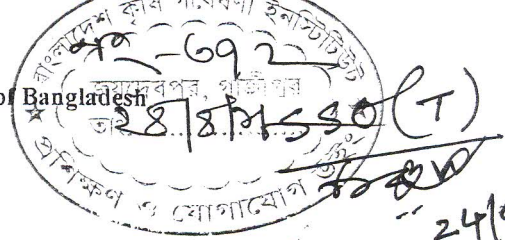



2. Terms and Conditions:

- a) Duration of the program including the transit time will be treated as on duty;
- b) They will draw their pay and allowances in local currency, no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
- c) All the expenses will be borne by the **National Agricultural Technology Program-Phase II Project (PMU Part)**;
- d) They will leave Bangladesh for Vietnam and Philippines on 23 April 2018 or on a nearer date and will leave Vietnam/Philippines for Bangladesh on 02 May 2018 or on a nearer date;
- e) They will not be allowed to stay abroad more than the approved period;
- f) They will have to submit a report to the Ministry of Agriculture within 7 (seven) days (as per prescribed format of MoPA) after return from the Program.
